

USDA young chicken harvest was up slightly vs. the prior week at 163.8 million head but was still down 1.2% from the prior year when the harvest was 165.8 million head. The National Composite whole birds and WOGs were steady last week. Looking at the parts, most remained firm with gains noted in the tenderloin and thigh meat segments. Within the white meat segment, B/S breasts were flat w/w at \$1.76/lb, and chicken tenderloins were higher by 2.3% w/w to \$2.13/lb. Both saw reduced promotions in the retail market. Wings were down slightly last week by \$.01 to \$2.26/lb, but drumsticks were higher at \$.43/lb. Thigh meat was mixed as B/I thighs were down slightly at \$.91/lb and boneless thigh meat moved higher by 1.75% to \$1.64/lb last week. The turkey segment traded lower last week with breasts down almost 3%. Looking ahead, chicken will remain a staple in the retail sector as the value-priced leader to keep consumers coming into stores. But beef and pork will also garner more ad space heading into the Memorial Day holiday. FOB per pound except when noted.
